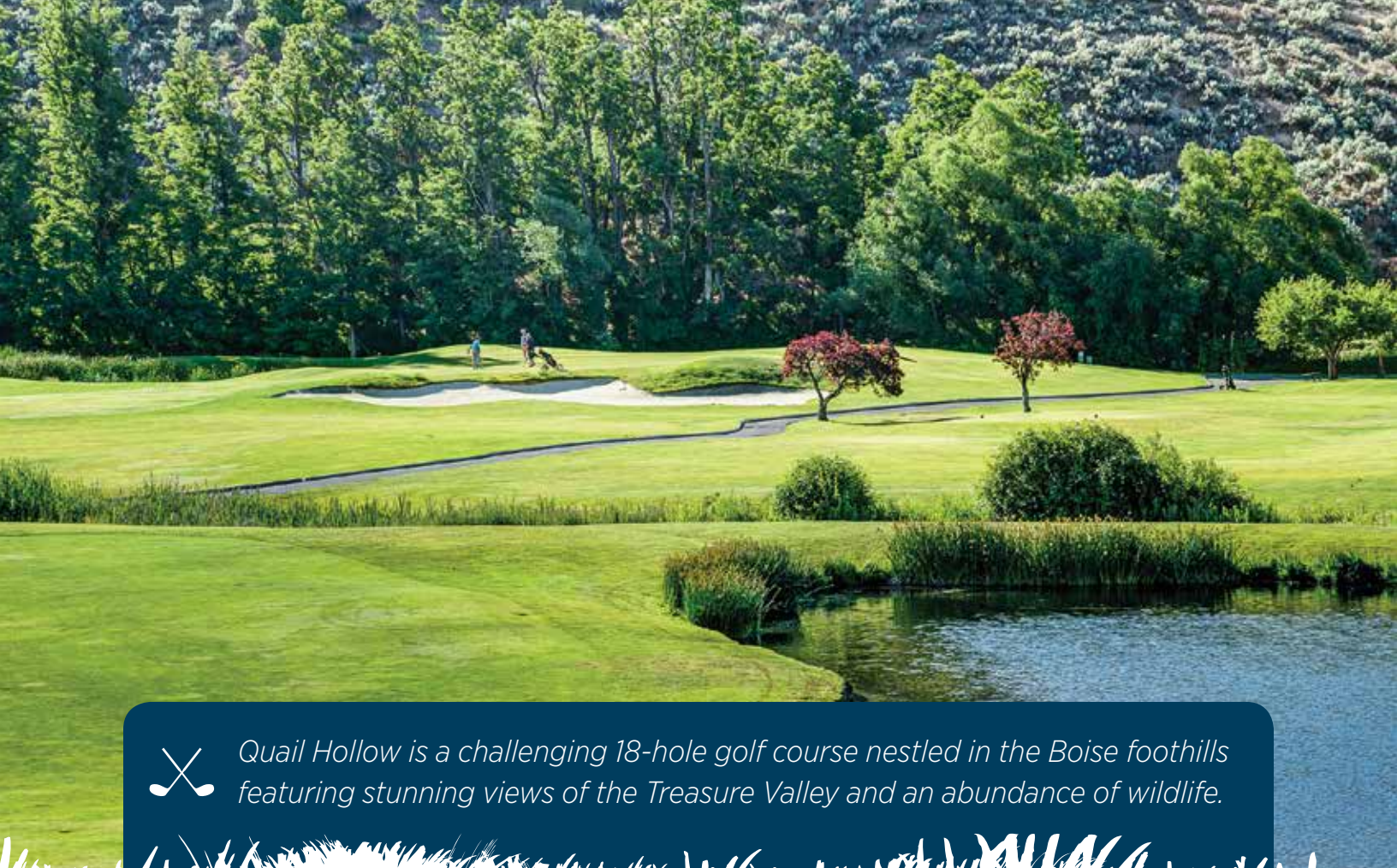

Quail Hollow is a challenging 18-hole golf course nestled in the Boise foothills featuring stunning views of the Treasure Valley and an abundance of wildlife.

The Golf Course

Quail Hollow was designed by Bruce Devlin and Robert von Hagge. This par-70 course is 6,373 yards from the tips. Don't let the yardage fool you, Quail Hollow is a course that is both challenging and exciting for golfers and non-golfers alike.

Quail Hollow Golf Course is located on 36th Street just north of Hill Road in Boise, Idaho. Quail Hollow is owned by the City of Boise and is operated by the Parks and Recreation Department.
